

## Tatartstan Aircompany - Boeing 737-500

**Date of Loss: 17th November 2013**

A Tatarstan Aircompany Boeing 737-53A operated on behalf of AK Bars Aero crashed on approach to Kazan Airport, Republic of Tatarstan, Russia.

According to reports the aircraft was on a flight (U9-363) from Moscow-Domodedovo to Kazan when on its third attempt at landing it reportedly struck the ground hard and burst into flames.

It has been confirmed that all forty-four passengers and six crew were killed in the accident that happened at 19:25 local time. Weather at the time was reported as light snow and rain.

It is reported that the son of the president of the Republic of Tatartstan was on board the aircraft.
